

REVISED RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR MACHINERY (2' RULE)

The two (2') foot rule has been eliminated for machinery. However, controllers, moveable tables, skids and other machine components, including human operators, **must** clear the aisles for security and fire marshal regulations. It is suggested that exhibitors give themselves the necessary space (at least 1') around the perimeter of their booth when working with riggers to spot machinery. In addition, there can be no selling, demonstrating or exhibiting machinery in the aisles. Exhibitors will not be able to operate machinery from their controllers if the panels and human operators are not within the confines of the booth.

Working machines must be shielded to prevent sparks, metal pieces and cutting fluids in order to avoid injury to others.

Exhibit materials and signage are limited to 12-feet in height. Machinery has no height limit.

Display materials placed within 5' of the aisle may not exceed 4' in height when within 10 feet from any neighbor (all booths, except islands).
